Memory is quite central for me. Part of it is that I like the actual texture of writing through memory.

When you become a parent, or a teacher, you turn into a manager of this whole system. You become the person controlling the bubble of innocence around a child, regulating it.

You need to remember that. If you're to have decent lives, you have to know who you are and what lies ahead of you, every one of you.

Now when I look back to the Guildford of that time it seems far more exotic to me than Nagasaki.

It had never occurred to me that our lives, which had been so closely interwoven, could unravel with such speed.

Indeed â€" why should I not admit it? â€" in that moment, my heart was

breaking.

I cannot start a story or chapter without knowing how it ends. ... Of course, it rarely ends that way.

Your life must now run the course that's been set for it.

Screenplays I didn't really care about, journalism, travel books, getting my writer friends to write about their dreams or something. I just determined to write the books I had to write.

When a man induces his wife to turn suspicious thoughts against her own father, then that is surely cause enough for resentment.

If you look at my last songs and first short stories, there is a real connection between them.

I was a little concerned that a lot of people thought I wrote Merchant Ivory movies. I also thought if I was ever going to write something strange and difficult, that was the time.

I think I had actually served my apprenticeship as a writer of fiction by writing all those songs. I had already been through phases of autobiographical or experimental stuff.

There comes a point when you can more or less count the number of

books you're going to write before you die.

It is one of the enjoyments of retirement that you are able to drift through the day at your own pace, easy in the knowledge that you have put hard work and achievement behind you.

I can't even say I made my own mistakes. Really - one has to ask oneself - what dignity is there in that?

My friends and I took songwriting very, very seriously. My hero was and still is Bob Dylan, but also people like Leonard Cohen and Joni Mitchell and that whole generation.

I want my words to survive translation.

~Kazuo Ishiguro

All children have to be deceived if they are to grow up without trauma.

~Kazuo Ishiguro

An artist's concern is to capture beauty wherever he finds it.

We took away your art because we thought it would reveal your souls. Or to put it more finely, we did it to prove you had souls at all.

To see the best before I have properly begun would be somewhat premature.

The problem, as I see it, is that you've been told and not told. You've been told, but none of you really understand, and I dare say, some people are quite happy to leave it that way.

When I see films made from books, I make a huge effort not to remember the book. It's important to see the film as a film.

There's a practical problem about time and energy, and a more subtle problem of what it does to a writer's head, to continually analyze why they write, where it all comes from, where it's going to.

I wouldn't want to try to adapt something of my own. It would be like going back to school and doing all my exams again.

When I was younger, I didn't read that much. I was more interested in film and music. Now I'm curious. I want to know what it's all about.

What I wished more than anything was that the thing hadn't happened at all, and I thought that by not mentioning it I'd be doing everyone else

a favor.

~Kazuo Ishiguro

My donors have always tended to do much better than expected.

~Kazuo Ishiguro

She might be a great person, but life's so much bigger than just loving someone.

~Kazuo Ishiguro

I don't have a deep link with England like, say, Jonathan Coe or Hanif Kureishi might demonstrate. For me it is like a mythical place.

One is not struck by the truth until prompted quite accidentally by some external event.

I don't think it's any fun, even if you are one of the most respected authors in the world like Margaret Atwood, to keep being nominated and not win.

I try to always go for something... very interior, following thoughts and memories, something that I think is difficult to do on the screen, which is essentially a third-person medium.

And if these incidents now seem full of significance and all of a piece, it's probably because I'm looking at them in the light of what came later.

So why not become a mongrel? It's healthy

I really have to think of the things fiction can do that film can't and play to the strengths of the novel. With a novel you can get right inside somebody's head.

There was surely nothing to indicate at the time that such evidently small incidents would render whole dreams forever irredeemable.

I grew up in Britain before it became a multicultural place, so in many ways I have a nostalgia for an England that's vanished - the England of my childhood has actually disappeared.

People were incredibly kind to our family and went out of their way to help.

I like novelists who can create other interesting worlds.

~Kazuo Ishiguro

I think it's quite difficult to understand what kind of life a writer leads. They might be millionaires, or they might be starving people.

And I'm a Hailsham student - which is enough by itself sometimes to get people's backs up.

I felt slightly superior to student politics, for instance. I had no reason to think this, but I thought of myself as slightly more seasoned. I became quite cynical talking to my student friends.
